LANDMARK SERIES

Boordy's Landmark wines are the finest expressions of the vintage year, varietal character, the geography of our region, and our winemakers' craft. The crisp, delicate whites and rosés, and deep earthy reds of the Landmark Series are handcrafted from 100% Maryland grown grapes, principally sourced from Boordy's estate vineyards.

More than 75 years of growing grapes and making wines in Maryland has taught us the foundations of good wine: a superior vineyard site, prudent varietal selection, meticulous care of our vines, and uncompromising attention to detail in the winery.

ESTATE VINEYARDS & WINEMAKING

At 39°N latitude, Maryland is in the heart of the temperate zone for viticulture in the Northern Hemisphere. Our state's varied geography and long growing season provide excellent conditions for growing premium wine grape varieties. Boordy farms estate vineyards in the rolling Piedmont Plateau north of the Chesapeake Bay and in the western Blue Ridge Province, producing flavorful, balanced grapes by controlling crop size, carefully managing the leaf canopy, selective harvesting, and hand sorting of the fruit.

Our state-of-the-art winery enables our winemakers to practice minimal handling of the grapes to preserve their full expression; great care is taken to respect the delicacy of the fruit. Landmark red wines and reserve whites are fermented in French oak to contribute body and aromatic nuance to the wines. The reds are given a minimum of 18 months barrel age and 18 months of bottle age before release.

The "Dry Bench" designation on our Landmark labels refers to discrete bands of rocky, low fertility ground in our vineyards that yield small crops of exceptional fruit which we reserve for our finest, most distinctive wines.



Boordy Vineyards has been growing and making fine wines in Maryland since 1945. Located in rural Baltimore County on the historic R. B. Deford Family farm, which has been placed in permanent preservation, Boordy is a Maryland landmark that welcomes visitors year-round.

Our Landmark labels capture the traditional beauty of Boordy, with a handsome line drawing representing the classic "Barn" series, and an elegant etching gracing the "Dry Bench Reserve" wines.
